# Parent and Child Transitions

## DIVORCE IS...

... a time of transition. Because of the tremendous changes in the family that occur as a result of divorce, both parents and children are likely to experience unanticipated problems, stress related illnesses, and feelings of failure, helplessness and confusion.

Children in particular have difficulty in adjusting and often assume the blame for their parents' divorce. Behavior problems, declining school performance, and emotional problems frequently result.

The negative effects of divorce can be less traumatic for all concerned if issues are faced and dealt with in a positive manner. The purpose of PARENT AND CHILD TRANSITIONS is to provide the opportunity for this to occur.
